



CRT PROM NITE HARTFORD “GET YA MIND RIGHT” VIDEO CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

Create a one minute video to answer the question: How can alcohol ruin your prom night and possibly your future?

1] ELIGIBILITY

- a. The CRT Prom Nite Hartford “Get Ya Mind Right” video contest is open to all high school seniors, able to provide proof of good academic standing, enrolled in Weaver, Bulkeley, and Hartford Public High Schools. Employees, agents, successors and assignees of Dressler Strickland, LLC, Mega Education LLC, affiliated entities, affiliated advertising agencies, participating sponsors, promotional partners and the members of their immediate families and household members of same are ineligible to participate in the CRT Prom Nite Hartford “Get Ya Mind Right” video contest.
- b. Only one (1) winner will be chosen. To be eligible to win any prize connected with the CRT Prom Nite Hartford “Get Ya Mind Right” Video Contest, contestants must:
 1. Complete the CRT Prom Nite Hartford – “Get Ya Mind Right” Application.
 2. The parent or guardian of students under the age of 18 shall sign same.
 3. Applications/ entry form, release must be Mailed or delivered to the attention of **Declon Joseph @ 1445 Main St. Hartford, CT 06105 or 8 Stonington St. Hartford, CT 06106** no later than 6PM on April 6th, 2009. Videos may be submitted on a DVD-R or electronically by uploading a video to YouTube (www.youtube.com) and emailing a link to your video to josephd@crtct.org . 2] SUBMITTED VIDEO GUIDELINES

- a. Submit footage on DVD-R only, with students name and school clearly printed on DVD with permanent marker
- b. Student video must answer question” How can alcohol ruin your prom night and possibly your future?”
- c. Student must state his/her first and last name, age and school at beginning of video.
- d. Video shall contain NO profanity, nudity and or sexual content (video with such content will be disqualified)
- e. Submitted video must be no longer than 1 min.
- f. Student must attach a short written bio including plans after high school graduation.
- g. Parents of all students under 18 years of age who appear in video must sign a release form (see attached).
- h. Contest Deadline April 6th, 2009 6 p.m. (late entries will NOT be accepted)

3] PRIZES

- a. The selected student and 3 guests will receive free limousine transportation for the evening of the prom. In addition, the winners will be filmed, as cast members, in a CRT Prom Nite Hartford “Get Ya Mind Right” reality film. Said film may be edited and disseminated in part, or in its entirety, at the discretion of CRT and/or Mega Education and disseminated on the world wide web, television, radio and/or other media.
- b. Prizes must be utilized in association with an officially sponsored school prom.

4] SELECTION OF WINNERS -RULES AND GUIDELINES

- a. Decisions of Management with respect to the contest are final.
- b. Management reserves the right to discontinue or terminate the contest if there is no contest winner(s).
Participants will be notified of contest's termination via www.MegaEducation.com.
- c. Winners will be advised via U.S. mail, fax or e-mail forwarded to the student's school.
- d. Each winner and each guest must sign release forms authorizing the use of their respective likeness in said prom night reality film, which will be disseminated on the world wide web, television, radio and/or other media.
(Parents must sign the release forms for participants under 18years of age)
- e. Winners of the CRT Prom Nite Hartford "Get Ya Mind Right video contest" must provide two (2) forms of identification, one of which must be a photo I.D. Acceptable forms of identification include: Birth Certificate, Driver's License, State ID Card, or United States Passport. Student's identification must be verified by school official.
- f. Winner and each guests MUST commit to not drink alcohol for the night
- g. Winner and guests must commit to being filmed and participate in pre and post prom events
- h. Winner and guests must commit to pre and post prom interview and post prom reviewing of film.
- i. entries will be judged on content and creativity.
- j. Winner must choose guests and submit their release forms by April 24th at 6pm.

5] CONDITIONS

- a. Contest winners are subject to participating sponsors' rules & regulations and will be required to sign a liability release prior to acceptance of any prize. Pursuant to the liability release, the winners will agree to hold harmless participating sponsors, CRT, Mega Education LLC, Dressler Strickland LLC, and/or individual attorneys thereof, student's school, school system, respective city or town, State of Connecticut, if applicable, corporate licensee, parent corporation, affiliated companies and the officers, shareholders, directors, employees, agents and representatives of each of them against any and all claims or liability arising directly or indirectly from the prize or contest.
- b. CRT reserves the right to make changes in contest rules which will become effective upon announcement.
- c. No purchase necessary. The contest is void where prohibited.
- d. Failure to comply with contest rules may result in contestant's disqualification.
- e. By entering your work for consideration, you attest that you have read, understand, and agree to all entry guidelines and requirements.
