RSCO SCHOOL PROGRAM TYPES

MAGNET SCHOOLS (Grades PK3-12)

(Theme-Based schools)

Magnet schools are unique programs that focus on specific themes, such as science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM); visual and performing arts; International Baccalaureate; and the Montessori method of teaching or other specialized instruction that fits the natural talents and interest of students.

- Offer free public elementary and secondary "schools of choice"
- Focus on diversity to give students a global educational experience that reflects the "real world" around them and prepares them for success in college and beyond
- Use hands-on, customized instruction to bring learning to life, engage students in their education, and provide students with a variety of courses and experiences to develop their interests and natural talents
- Spark a lifelong love of learning in a fun, dynamic environment
- Provide a theme-based program that excites, engages and inspires kids to learn every day



TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOLS (CTECS) (Grades 9–12) (Career and College Readiness Programs)

CTECS technical high schools provide students in grade 9 to 12 with the opportunity to master skills in a career and technical education (CTE) program while completing core academic subjects. They offer state-of-the-art classrooms; latest instructional technology and industry-standard equipment give students a well-rounded, 21st century education.

- Combine core academics and specialized career/technical education
- Award students a high school diploma, plus a certificate in their technical field
- Prepare students for immediate employment, apprenticeship programs, or college

OPEN CHOICE SCHOOLS (Grades PK4–12) Culturally Diverse Schools Reflecting the Real World

The Open Choice Program is a public school program that provide students who live in Hartford to attend public schools in nearby suburban school districts, and students who live outside of Hartford to attend certain public schools in Hartford. Through the Open Choice Program Hartford resident students are able to access the benefits of academic programming in suburban communities and learn and play alongside students from a school district outside of Hartford. Suburban resident students are able to access the benefits of special programming in Hartford schools.

- Allow children to learn in a culturally diverse school district outside of their town
- Offer high-quality academic programs that prepare students for future success
- Support kids in building knowledge, personal connections and an understanding of diverse cultures to prepare for success as an adult
- Most graduates attend post-secondary education programs, including four-year colleges such as Clark, UConn, ECSU, Lesley, CCSU, Western New England, the University of Hartford (grants available for Hartford residents), Johnson and Wales, and the University of Florida.
